What does it mean to be fully vaccinated?

For individuals who reside in the United States, you are currently considered "fully vaccinated" when it has been at least two weeks since you received the final dose, as recommended by the manufacturer, of a vaccine that has been authorized by the FDA for use in the United States (e.g., Pfizer, Moderna, Johnson & Johnson, etc.), including any and all vaccinations that have been approved pursuant to an Emergency Use Authorization in the United States.

For individuals who reside outside of the United States, you are currently considered "fully vaccinated" when it has been at least two weeks since you received the final dose, as recommended by the manufacturer, of a vaccine that is listed for emergency use by the World Health Organization (WHO) (e.g., AstraZeneca/Oxford, etc.).

If the event is held in a country or location where the legal definition or test for determining when an individual is "fully vaccinated" is mandated or guided by applicable law, then such legal definition or test for that country or location shall apply for individuals attending the event in that country or location.

Please note that the current Covid-19 pandemic is a fluid situation and, as such, the Company, in its sole discretion, reserves the right to modify or change the definition(s) of "fully vaccinated" as listed above to the maximum extent permitted by applicable law.

Do I have to provide proof of vaccination?

Unless otherwise prohibited by applicable law, the Company may require you to provide proof of vaccination to gain entry into the event and, as such, all participants are advised to bring proof of their vaccination with them to the event.

Do I have to provide a negative COVID-19 test to attend the event?

Unless required by the venue or applicable law, rule or ordinance, the Company does not have any plans at this time to require a negative COVID-19 test to attend the event. As noted above though, the current Covid-19 pandemic is a fluid situation and, as such, the Company, in its sole discretion, reserves the right to modify or change this requirement to the maximum extent permitted by applicable law.

Will it be mandatory that I have to wear a mask, socially distance, or follow any other mandatory COVID-19 safety protocols?

Event attendees will be required to comply, at all times, with all applicable COVID-19 rules, regulations, and safety protocols that are in place at the time of the event. However, as current Covid-19 pandemic is a fluid situation, COVID-19 safety protocols for the event(s) will be dictated at the time of the applicable event(s) by applicable local laws, rules and ordinances as well as WHO and/or CDC guidance (as applicable) along with the applicable event venue's specific requirements.

If I have tested positive for COVID-19, can I still attend the event?

If you have either (i) tested positive for COVID-19 in the ten (10) days prior to the event, (i) are still subject to a quarantine or isolation requirement, or (iii) have any symptoms of COVID-19, you may not attend the event. Additionally, if you are feeling ill regardless of whether you are exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19, we ask that you stay home and not attend the event as well.

Please note that if the country or location where the event is being held has requirements **greater** than those listed above, the applicable country or locations requirements will apply in lieu of those listed above.
