1,800 leaders share views on user expectations, hybrid work, IT, and obstacles & strategies for DEX

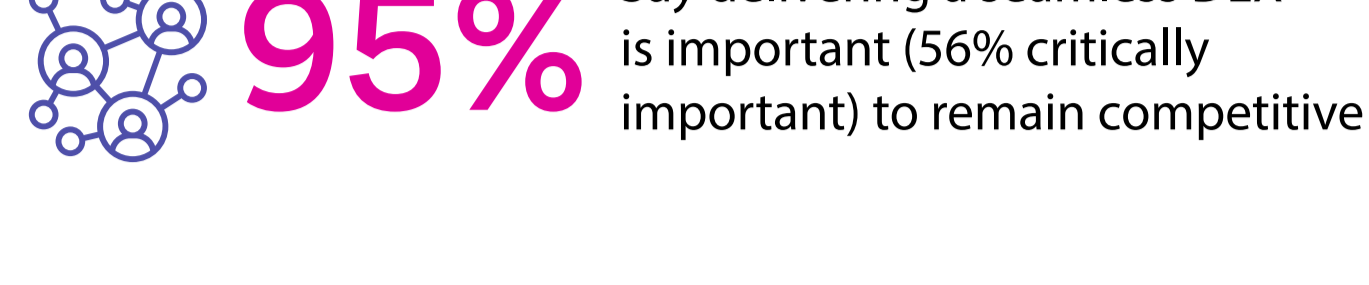

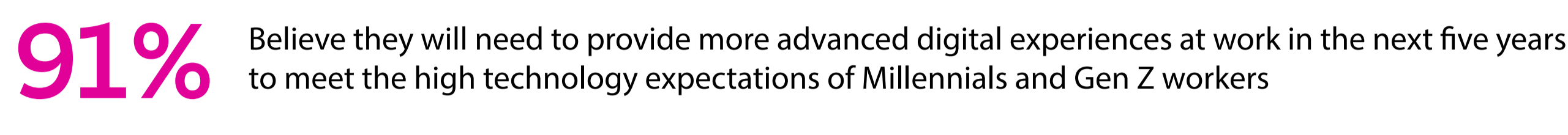
